***UNSETTLED* wins Grand Jury Prize for Best Documentary Feature at 2007  
Slamdance Film Festival**

*First-time director's debut takes top prize in fest lineup selected from 3600 submissions*

**PARK CITY – RESONANCE PICTURES** is proud to announce the selection of ***UNSETTLED*** as the best documentary at this year's Slamdance Film Festival. Following two sold-out screenings and several public appearances with hip-hop/reggae star Matisyahu to promote the film, first-time director Adam Hootnick gratefully accepted the Slamdance "Sparky" award for best doc at a ceremony at Park City's Treasure Mountain Inn on Friday. "I'm overwhelmed," Hootnick said. "To win this award from a festival organized by other indie filmmakers who have fought the same obstacles to make their own films means more to me than anything."

***UNSETTLED*** is the emotional story of six young people struggling to navigate the complex dynamics of democracy, religion, and community during the Israeli withdrawal from Gaza in 2005. Hootnick spent three years as a producer at MTV before starting production on the film, which features twenty-something surfers, soldiers, and religious settlers thrust to the front lines of a conflict in which the lines are all blurred. He now hopes to continue the film's successful festival run and is in conversation with potential distributors.
